- Earn no more than 200% over the Federal Poverty Guidelines;
- Proof of residency;
- No medical or dental insurance; no private source of health care assistance
- *Children under the age of 18 are not eligible for service in the Oxford Medical Ministries Clinic as they are covered by Mississippi Children's Health Insurance Coverage (CHIPS) and Medicaid.*
